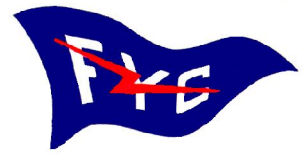

2010 Boat of the Year Qualifications



Ford Yacht Club offers perpetual trophies for the Boat of the Year in PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF JAM and MORC. To be eligible for these prestigious awards you must meet the following criteria:

- Be a member of Ford Yacht Club in good standing
- Be a member of PHRF-LE or MORC
- Complete a minimum of seven counter races (Boats may use a race in an alternative class if their normal class is not available, e.g. A JAM boat may use a spinnaker race where there is no JAM class).
- Race at least two of the FYC races designated (**) below.
- Also race at least one of the races listed below offered by each, Grosse Ile Yacht Club and West Shore Sail Club (reciprocal agreement)
- Submit results of races you wish to be considered by October 10, 2010

The winner of each trophy will be determined using the Modified Cox Sprague system based on percentages, posted on the FYC website <http://www.fordyachtclub.com>: => Sailing. The position for each race will be based on your finish time within your class. The best seven races (highest Cox Sprague value) will be counted.

In the case of a tie, the following procedure will be used:

- The best finish in the two mandatory Ford Yacht Club races
- The best of the total Cox-Sprague scores in Ford Yacht Club races (not raced=0)
- The best finish in a race not used in the original seven
- The best overall finish in seven counter races or series

You must submit the results of all the races you wish to have considered. These results are to include your corrected elapsed time, your place in the class, and the number of boats racing in your class. This data must be submitted no later than **October 10, 2010!**

FYC considers up to two races 'out of the area' (start line at least 10 nautical miles from FYC and not on the list below). The race must either have 5 boats or more in the class raced and have at least two classes or be a one-design sanctioned event. Race must be between October 1, 2009 and September 30, 2010. Acceptance of the race(s) is at the discretion of the FYC race committee.
